DP080027261 – Death Investigation – 1 East 36th Street Homicide is investigating the death of a 4 month old infant. The father said he laid the child down, and he later noticed that the child was not breathing.

SUMMARIES OF VIOLENT CRIMES

DP080023803 – Rape – 2000 Stoneham Drive - Female victim stated that her husband arrived home both drunk and high on drugs. Her husband became violent toward her and began striking her and her daughter. Her husband then forced her to have both oral sex and intercourse while the children were present throughout this incident.

DP080024598 – Aggravated Assault – 2000 Amerherst

Dr - The victims were inside their apartment. The 3 suspects entered the door. They asked to see someone who was supposed to be there. When one of the victims told the suspects that the person was not there, the suspects entered the apartment and struck the victims with a baseball bat. Officers arrived and found the one of the victims with a head wound, and the other was unconscious. Both were taken to the hospital. Aggravated Assault detectives assisted.

DP080024059 – Aggravated Assault – 5200 Oakleaf Dr Male victim advises that he and his girlfriend had been drinking. They had gotten into an argument and his girlfriend pushed him forward onto his face and stabbed him in the back shoulder area with a knife should had obtained from the kitchen.
